The starting point to do so is within a Category (or on the top level of the Repository).

To create a Course, do the following:

1. Choose the „Course“ option from the "Add New Item" menu on top right.
2. A new field appears within which you may add a title and description to the new Course.
3. Finally, click the „Add Course“ button.

You get to the edit mode of your new Course where you are offered facilities as well to apply objects within the Course, as to access its different properties.
